(make lasso movement)


One little stone went up, up, up

Application Questions

- 3. Why do you think he got 5 stones from the stream instead of just one? (maybe he thought it would take more than one time for him to hit Goliath, he wanted to be prepared)
- 4. Do you think that loving God and having faith depends on how old you are? (various answers; you can be young and still be brave and have faith in God)
- 5. Do you think his brothers were surprised when he defeated the giant? (yes, they probably thought he couldn't do it because he was just their little brother)
- 6. Do we sometimes have to face "Goliaths," in our lives, problems that seem too big or scary to fight? (yes, various answers)
- 7. Just like David, who helps us win these battles? (God, Jesus, our Christian friends and families)
