


Joshua

So the Lord was with Joshua, and Joshua became famous through all the land.


Joshua Puppet Script

When the evil men came she didn't tell. (evil men appear to LEFT of Rahab, look around a bit and leave)

The spies were grateful for Rahab's aid. (take cloth off spies)
To save her and her family a promise they made.
"When we come back to take over this town
A piece of red rope out your window let down." (let red rope down)

"Your father and mother and brothers and you
Will not die that day, God's promise is true."



So early one morning, God's Word on their mind
The people and Joshua a victory to find. (Joshua appears RIGHT)
First came the soldiers leading the way (soldiers appear LEFT of Joshua)
Next came the priests with trumpets to play. (priest appear on RIGHT of Joshua)

Round the fair city, God's people they walked (Walk LEFT, disappear, appear RIGHT and repeat)
The priests blew their trumpets, the soldiers never talked.
For six full days, they marched round the town.
On the 7th things changed, as again they marched round.

Seven times the 7th day, they marched round the wall
With trumpets and shouts, the bricks they did fall. (wall begins to break)
The win was the Lord's, and the walls tumbled down, (walls go down)
Rahab was safe, (Rahab appears behind her rope) with God they were sound.







Application Questions

5. The spies saved Rahab and her family from dying when the walls of Jericho fell because she helped the spies. Does God save people today who follow him? (yes)
6. Joshua and his men obeyed exactly what the Lord told them to do. Do you try to obey your parents and your teachers when they tell you to do something exactly? (yes, my mommy has a special place for my toys, my shirts go in a special drawer)
7. We obey our parents and our teachers. Who else should we obey? (God, the Bible)
